

### Title

Field Instructor based in WY. Field instructing in WY, CO, AZ, UT.

### Status

Seasonal: May through August. Employed on a contract basis per course.

### Pay

Salary is based upon experience and evaluation on the WMPC course. For first year instructors, pay is usually between \$50 and \$60 per day. SROM will provide housing for course prep and course closure dates

### Goal

To safely and effectively facilitate the mission of SROM (leading people to a knowledge of Jesus Christ in the outdoors; creating a divine-human encounter; and equipping, refocusing, and renewing of individuals in God's creation and the Holy Spirit), SROM values (The Glory of God, Jesus Christ and His Kingdom, Fathering and Family, and the Nations), and SROM core course components (spiritual transformation, authentic community, character formation, leadership development, and skill acquisition).

### SROM Values

The applicant must believe in the centrality, supremacy, and lordship of Jesus Christ, and must desire to live as a disciple of Jesus Christ. He or she is expected to strive to grow in intimacy with Jesus, keeping Christ as the center and circumference of their life. He or she is expected to live in the light with Christian believers in the context of community, and strive to demonstrate the character of Jesus and the fruit of the spirit in daily Christian living. He or she must competently integrate faith and prayer into their job description and be committed to living for the glory of God as a lifestyle. The applicant must read and agree to SROM's mission statement and articles of faith which can be found on the website.

### Qualifications

- Valid driver's license
- Proficient in one of the following areas: rock climbing, backpacking, and mountaineering
- Must pass SROM's certifying course, the Wilderness Ministry Professionals Course (WMPC)
- Minimum Wilderness First Aid (WFA) and CPR medical certifications. Wilderness First Responder highly recommended.
- All instructors are required to carry their own personal medical or accident insurance throughout the summer.
- Instructors interested in working courses with a rock climbing component must also pass SROM's Rock Instructor I course.

### Expectations

*Reports to: Course Logistics Manager, Course Management*

- Course preparation – Student preparation, pre-course paperwork, itinerary design and planning, food preparation, equipment preparation, student orientation, etc.
- Facilitation of the SROM mission, values and core components while on the SROM course. Additionally, Instructors will teach rock climbing, backpacking, mountaineering, backcountry living, LNT practices, risk management, judgment and decision making, leadership development, etc.
- Course closure – Post-course paperwork, debrief with students and course managers, equipment clean-up, food clean-up, etc.

**Application Process:** You must complete the online application, and submit your resume and three reference forms. Interviews are scheduled as needed. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
